

House rules

ENTRY AND BEHAVIOUR

- Visitors under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be denied entry.
- Alcohol is only served to guests aged 18 and older. If you pass alcohol to someone under 18, or if you're under 18 and caught drinking, you'll be asked to leave.
- Visitors may be recorded on camera.
- For everyone's safety, please follow instructions from our staff at all times.

SMOKING, SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Smoking and the use of e-cigarettes are only allowed in the designated outdoor areas. Smoking indoors is not permitted under national regulations.
- Weapons, knives, and hard drugs are strictly forbidden. If found in possession, the police will be notified.
- Security checks may include bag searches and body pat-downs upon entry.
- Sound levels can exceed 80 dBA. Protecting your hearing is your own responsibility.

RESPECT AND CONDUCT

- If you experience or witness any form of nuisance or intimidation, please report it immediately to a staff member — security, bar staff or glass collectors. We'll take action right away.

NOT ALLOWED

- The sale or use of soft or hard drugs.
- Bringing your own food, drinks, stickers, or markers.
- Taking glassware outside.
- Any behaviour or remarks towards guests or staff that are racist, sexist, homophobic, transphobic, xenophobic, fatphobic, ableist, ageist, or in any other way aggressive, discriminatory, or intimidating.
